Health Awareness – Bowel Cancer

June is Bowel Cancer Awareness Month

Bowel cancer is the second deadliest cancer in Australia, claiming more than 100 lives every week. But the good news? It's also one of the most treatable cancers if detected early.

Early detection saves lives. If you're aged 50-74, you may be eligible for a free home screening test every two years through the National Bowel Cancer Screening Program. Don't ignore these warning signs:

- Changes in bowel habits (diarrhoea or constipation)
 - Blood in your stool
- Persistent abdominal pain, cramps, or bloating
 Unexplained fatigue or weight loss

Talk to your GP about symptoms, your risk factors, and available screening options. Even if you're younger than 50, bowel cancer can still affect you.

Private Patients, Children and those over 65 without a valid concession:

Today Medicare rebates do not cover the full cost of providing you with medical care. This is because the rate at which successive governments have indexed the Medicare Schedule fees has been substantially lower than increases in the Consumer Price Index (CPI) and average weekly earnings.

The reality is that Medicare rebates do not cover the cost of providing you with a safe and high-quality service. The fees charged by this practice have to cover all of our practice costs including the employment of doctors, receptionists and practice nurses, and meet our operating expenses such as rent, medical equipment, electricity, computers and insurance.

It is not possible for this practice to meet our running costs each year without increasing our fees.

From **1st July 2025** our practice will be charging you the following fees for our most common services & these payments are required on the day:

Private Children Rebate

Brief Consultation (Item 3) \$87.00

Standard Consultation (Item 23) \$115.00

Consultations > 20 minutes (Item 36) \$170.00

Consultations > 40 minutes (Item 44) \$220.00


Patients 65 years and older who hold a valid Pensioner Concession Card or a valid Health Care Card are eligible for **Medicare rebate** + **\$40 gap** on the day of their consultation.

Children 15 years and younger are eligible for **Medicare rebate** + **\$50 gap** on the day of their consultation.

Please note we no longer offer a \$10 discount to patients 16-64 years with a valid pension or concession card.

We have a TYRO facility available at reception. Once full payment is made for your consultation TYRO enables us to deposit the Medicare rebate back into a Cheque or Savings account using your card. This process is extremely quick and efficient.

The Medicare rebate will be updated as soon as Medicare release this data closer to July 1st

Sarah's Craft's Glass Bead Suncatcher

Ingredients:

- 1. Glass beads
- 2. Clear glue
- 3. Plastic lid
- 4. Needle
- 5. Fishing line
- 6. Suction cup hooks







Method

- Cover the bottom of a plastic lid with clear glue. Don't fill the entire lid – just add enough to create a thin layer of glue.
- 2. Press the glass beads into the glue, flat side down. Get creative and make some fun patterns, use different colours. Make sure to add as many beads as you can to fill the entire lid.
- 3. Allow the glue to dry for 4-5 days. You'll know the glue is dry when it peels away easily from the lid.
- 4. Once the glue is dry, remove the suncatcher from the plastic lid.
- 5. Using a thick needle, poke a hole in a thinner part of the glue. Cut approximately 11-12 inches of fishing line and feed it through the newly made hole.
- 6. Tie a knot in the fishing line and attach it to the hook of a suction cup.
- 7. Hang your suncatcher in the window and enjoy the colourful light shining through!
